RESOLUTION NO. 2023-08-413**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LYNN HAVEN, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A BEAUTIFICATION GRANT, AND ENTER INTO A BEAUTIFICATION GRANT, LANDSCAPE CONSTRUCTION, AND MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR ADDITIONAL LANDSCAPING ON HIGHWAY 77; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips within Department of Transportation rights of way must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Lynn Haven, Florida beautifies and improves various rights of way by landscaping within the City; and

WHEREAS, FDOT is offering a \$240,000 grant for continued Highway 77 beautification; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wish to authorize the Mayor or City Manager to apply for a Beautification Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation, and if awarded, to accept the grant, and enter into a Beautification Grant, Landscape Construction, and Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Lynn Haven and FDOT.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Lynn Haven as follows:


SECTION 1. The Mayor or City Manager to apply for a Beautification Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation, and if awarded, to accept the grant, and enter into a Beautification Grant, Landscape Construction, and Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City and the Florida Department of Transportation for landscaping of Highway 77 from CR3212/Baldwin Road to 3rd Street (Bailey Bridge) in Lynn Haven, Florida.

***SECTION 2.** The Mayor or City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and any documents associated with the grant and maintenance of the landscape project, a copy of which is to be placed on file in the City Manager/Clerk's Office.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
