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## CDBG SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Lynn Haven plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity for a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant of \$11,715,000 in the Economic Development category.

This grant application is intended to provide additional project funding for the budget shortfall of \$11,715,000. Overall project cost is estimated to be \$16,015,000. The project includes improvements and additions to streetscape, lighting, and landscape in one of the city's designated commercial districts located on Florida and Ohio Avenue, roughly between 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Street. Project activities will focus on the existing street right-of-way and include an ADA compliant update of the street and sidewalk corridors, landscaping improvements, as well as the update of street lighting. The City of Lynn Haven does not expect that anyone will be displaced because of CDBG funded activities.

A public hearing to provide citizens with an opportunity to comment on the application will be held at the Walter T. Kelley Commission Chambers located at 825 Ohio Ave on May 15, 2025, at 8:45 am.
