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CDBG SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Lynn Haven plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant of \$1,907,415 in the Neighborhood Revitalization category.

The city will rehab 9,300 LF of clay gravity sewer pipes and brick manholes that were installed in the 1960's to prevent failure due to deterioration by trenchless rehabilitation. Install 14,000 LF of new 6" water main to improve existing customer water supply reliability and fire flow protection coverage. The new watermain will be replacing approximately 500 LF of deteriorated 6" asbestos cement (AC) watermain and 13,500 LF of undersized 2" PVC water distribution lines where there is currently no fire flow available and there is low pressure at peak flow times. There will also be approximately 2.4 miles of roadways and rehabbed stormwater improvements on West 10th. St.

A public hearing to provide citizens with an opportunity to comment on the application will be held at the Walter T. Kelley Commission Chambers located at 825 Ohio Ave on May 13, 2025, at 8:30 am. A draft copy will also be available for review during normal business hours in City Hall by noon on May 9, 2025. A copy of the final application will be available for review at City Hall by noon on Tuesday, May 14, 2025. The application will be submitted to DEO on May 15, 2025.
