The City of Lynn Haven, Florida, will receive sealed bids from any qualified person, company or corporation interested in constructing the following project:

The project includes improvements to two stormwater outfalls, to include but not limited to pipe, inlets, headwalls, rip rap, armor form, concrete canvas, erosion control, sodding, minor excavation, and stabilization.

There will be no Mandatory pre-bid meeting for this project.

Bids will be received until **2:00p.m**, Local Time, **July 23, 2025**, at the Lynn Haven City Hall, 825 Ohio Avenue, Lynn Haven, Florida 32444, and will be opened and read aloud. **ALL BIDS SHOULD BE SEALED AND MARKED "Bid for CITY OF LYNN HAVEN LEGISLATIVE STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 1B"**.

All bidders shall be FDOT certified in the following major classes of work:

1. Drainage
2. Grading
3. Concrete
4. Grassing, Seeding and Sodding (can be subcontractor)

The person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid or a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract on a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, for Category Two for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

Bidders must comply with federal requirements to check debarment and suspension status of contractors, subcontractors and vendors per 2 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 200, Appendix II (H) and 31 CFR Part 19.

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The Owner has the right to waive any informalities, to reject any or all bids and modify quantities at any time.

Each bidder must provide a Bid Bond or security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information to Bidders.

Performance & Payment Bonds will be required from the awarded Bidder. Sureties used for obtaining bonds must appear as acceptable according to the Department of Treasury Circular 570.

The project is being funded by the Florida Legislature and there is no local preference.
